

Project Overview

Western Sydney University is embarking on an expansion of its prestigious Vice-Chancellery offices, located in the Executive Building of its Parramatta South Campus.

Delivered over two stages, Stage 1 includes the repurposing of adjacent teaching spaces, which will be refurbished to seamlessly integrate with the existing Vice-Chancellery space. Stage 2 involves the refurbishment and reconfiguration of existing areas within the Vice-Chancellery's northern wing, to improve its functionality.

The refurbished space will include a formal boardroom and a range of informal meeting rooms, event and quiet reflection spaces, private and open plan offices, gallery spaces and lounge areas, along with a range of amenities, including kitchens, alfresco dining spaces, a hot desk area and restrooms.

The interior design has been completed by Grimshaw, with the project further supported by a consulting team consisting of Northrop, Altus Group, Group DLA and AECOM.
